## RYSL Team Management Policy

071011

1. The RYSL Team Management Policy is designed to give the players in the RYSL the maximum opportunity to have fun while progressing through the different Age Groups learning to play the Game of Soccer.
2. The "**RYSL Team Management Policy**" is divided into two sections:
3. **Section One:**
  - A. When conditions exist within a team under the jurisdiction of the RYSL, which reflects poor management, abuse of the players, and/or are functioning in a way as to not be in the best interest of the RYSL or soccer in general. If any of these situations exist, the Board of Directors shall have the power to investigate such conditions and make appropriate recommendations, with a time line, to make needed corrections.
  - B. If the aforementioned recommendations are not adhered to, according to the time line, then the Board of Directors shall exercise its authority to suspend said team or team official(s) or to take the team over and find a new coach.
  - C. Ultimately, the RYSL BOD has the responsibility to make sure that the players of the RYSL are having a wholesome, fun and exciting experience and can take whatever actions are necessary to accomplish that responsibility.
4. **Section Two:**
  - A. When the spirit of the RYSL Recreation Philosophy is being abused or ignored, the Board of Directors shall have the power to make appropriate recommendations, with a time line, to bring the Coach, Players and/or Team back to the RYSL Recreation Philosophy.
  - B. If the aforementioned recommendations are not adhered to, according to the time line, then the Board of Directors shall exercise its authority to move said team to another Age Group or, if said team refuses, suspend said team or team official(s).
  - C. Ultimately, the RYSL BOD has the responsibility to make sure that the players of the RYSL are having a wholesome, fun and exciting experience and can take whatever actions are necessary to accomplish that responsibility.
